Any criticism, comment, evaluation, or observation regarding staff, including members of this administration, should be addressed exclusively in Closed Session. Anyone who makes defamatory remarks or makes personal attacks does so without the knowledge, authority, or approval of the Personnel Commission as a whole, or their Administration.

If you wish to ask questions, please address them to the Chairperson and not to individual members of the Personnel Commission or its staff.
