PUBLIC COMMENTS ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

Public Comments

Derrick Hefflin, Maintenance Worker II, raised his concerns on previous Board Report items. Mr. Hefflin stated that he was upset on an item on the board report that stated that a 3% salary increase was applied to Senior Directors and Administrator, but it wasn't specific of who received the increase. Mr. Hefflin felt that it was unfair to the classified employees that higher level positions were given a 3% increase in their salaries, while classified employees were laid off for either lack of funds or lack of work. Mr. Hefflin stated that there must be funds for the salary increases to take place, but yet employees are being laid off unfairly. He also stated that medical benefits have increased tremendously, there has not been a cost of living increase in eight years, and classified employees have not had raises.

Commissioner Vickers informed Mr. Hefflin that if he felt there was an injustice made, and classified employees were laid off for either lack of funds or lack of work, Mr. Hefflin should address his Union. Commissioner Vickers also suggested to Mr. Hefflin that he should call a meeting with classified employees, and file a grievance if, and when an injustice has been made

Commissioner Irving explained to Mr. Hefflin that the item he was referring to has been on hold for numerous years, and that the Board was trying to rectify it. Ms. Irving stated she was also concerned, and was going to bring forward her concern to the Personnel Commission because those that were going to receive the 3% raise are under classified personnel.

Mr. Adams, Sr. Director of Classified Personnel informed the Commissioners and those present at the meeting, that the Board item was only related to Certificated Management. The item didn't relate to Classified Management.

Ms. Adrianne Cleveland, SEIU Local 99 Field Representative, informed Personnel Commission that all staff under FMOT were asked to report to Willowbrook M. S. 7:30 a.m. for a safety training session. Ms. Cleveland brought forth her concerns, and stated how disillusioned she was after completing the training. Ms. Cleveland felt it was a waste of time, and in insult to her intelligence of the training staff received. Ms. Cleveland stated that she feels the leadership

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under FMOT is not leading the employees on the correct path to success, but of failure. Ms. Cleveland has requested that Human Resources and Personnel Commission should be involved in any and all training that will be sponsored by the District. Ms. Cleveland stated that the training received would endanger individuals, and would make it even more dangerous for FMOT staff to perform their duties.

Ms. Cleveland also raised a question in reference to an item number on the Agenda, and again she stated that the re-organization that's trying to take in effect within FMOT, has not accomplished nothing with the resources already in place. Ms. Cleveland also stated that FMOT is in the worst condition it is ever been. In the twenty-one years she's been employed with the District, she stated that she has never seen such lack of leadership, unorganized, and such disregard for the employees.
