Here are the answers:

What is Cal Grant? Free money for **California** students to go to a **California** college or university.

How many Cal Grants are there?

Cal Grant **A**: Must have 3.0 GPA

Cal Grant **B**: Must have 2.0 GPA

Cal Grant **C**: Anyone pursuing **Community College** or **trade/ vocational school**

What are the requirements for CAL GRANT?

Must submit a **FAFSA** or **Dream Act**

A minimum GPA of **2.0**

Must meet **Income** eligibility

Students who are **U.S Citizen** or **Eligible non-citizens**

How can I determine my Cal Grant?
