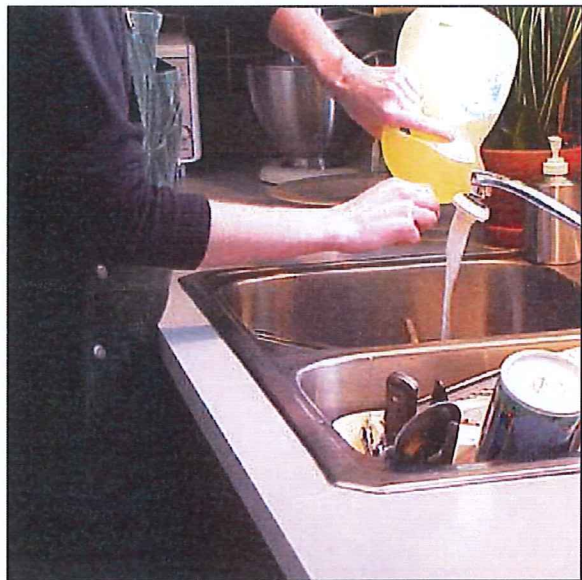

# Indoor Chores—Washing Dishes 1



When you are finished with a meal, there are many dishes to be washed.

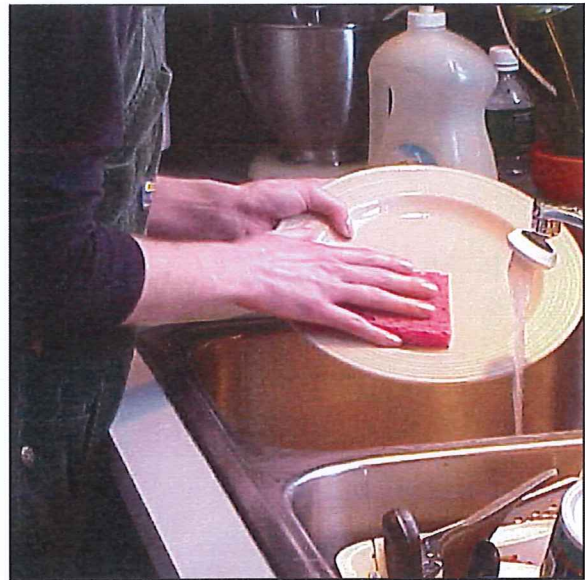


Use hot water and dish soap when filling the sink, but be careful not to burn yourself.

## Indoor Chores—Washing Dishes 2



Check the water with your hand to make sure it is not too hot.



Use a sponge or dish rag to scrub the dishes until they are clean and then rinse them in fresh water with no soap in it.

# Indoor Chores—Washing Dishes 3



Handle glass dishes gently so they do not break.

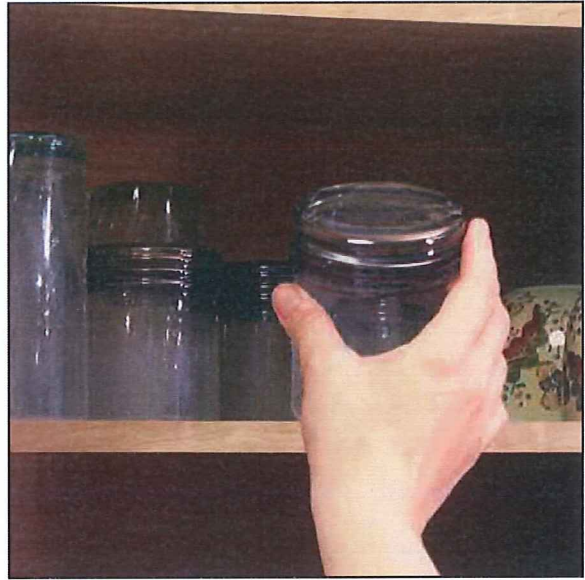


Be careful when washing sharp knives.

# Indoor Chores—Washing Dishes 4



Dry the dishes using a clean, dry towel.



Put plates and glasses back where they belong.

# Indoor Chores—Washing Dishes 5



Sort the silverware when putting it away.



It is important to do a good job washing dishes to remove germs that can make you sick.

# Outdoor Chores—Lawn Care 1



There are always chores to do outside.



One chore is mowing the grass. Never use a lawn mower without permission from an adult because they can be dangerous.

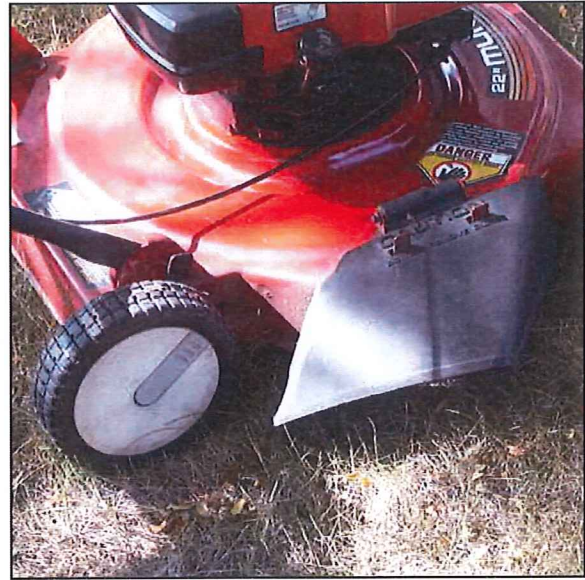


# Outdoor Chores—Lawn Care 2



Always wear shoes, long pants, and eye protection to protect you from things you might hit when mowing.

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Keep both hands on the handle and do not put hands or feet near the mower blade until it has stopped moving.

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# Outdoor Chores—Lawn Care 3



Use a rake to put leaves or grass into piles so it is easier to pick them up. When raking, wear gloves to prevent blisters on your hands.



Helping with outdoor chores is fun but you always need to be careful.

Follow instructions on the recipe and measure the ingredients carefully.

When the food is done cooking, turn off the oven and stove burners.



Clean up your work area and wash all cooking utensils with dish soap.

When you are done, wash your hands again.

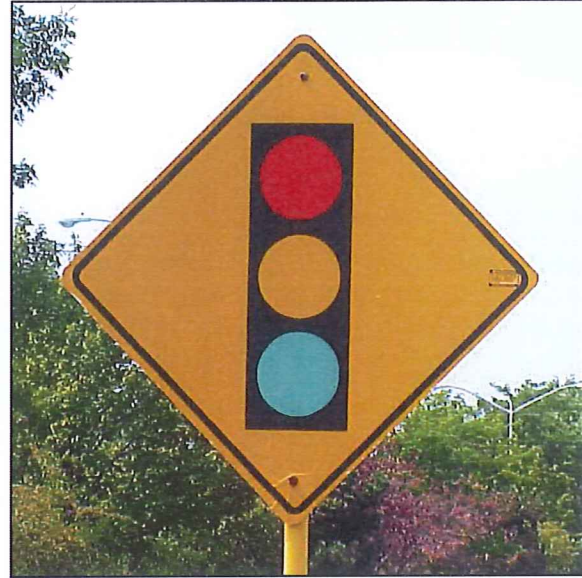

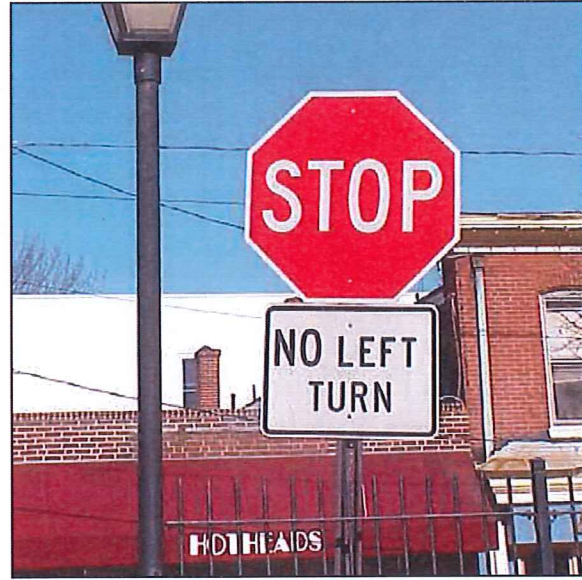
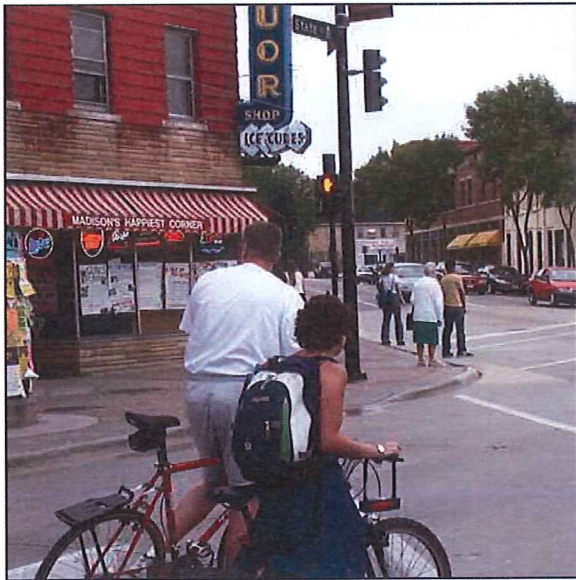

# City Signs 1

# City Signs 2

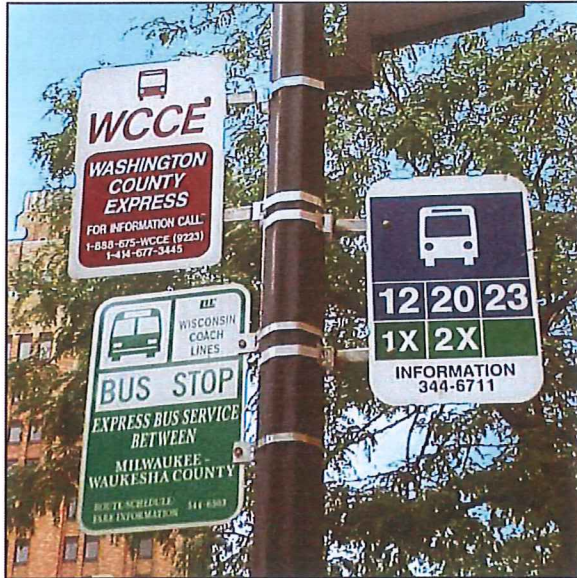


Some traffic signals tell you when and when not to cross the street.

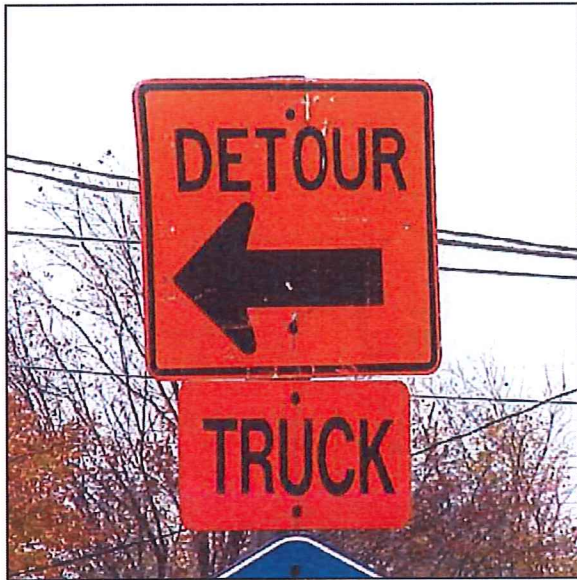


Look for School Crossing signs near your school. They tell you where to cross the street.

If you take a city bus, look for the bus stop signs. They tell you where the bus will stop to pick you up.

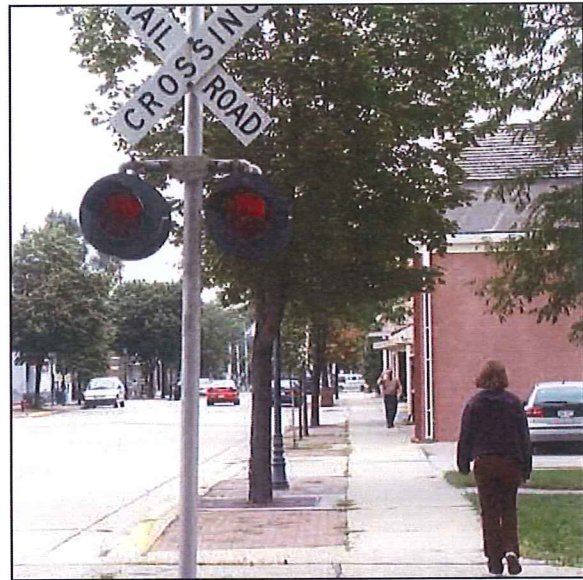


Orange signs warn you about construction zones.

# City Signs 4

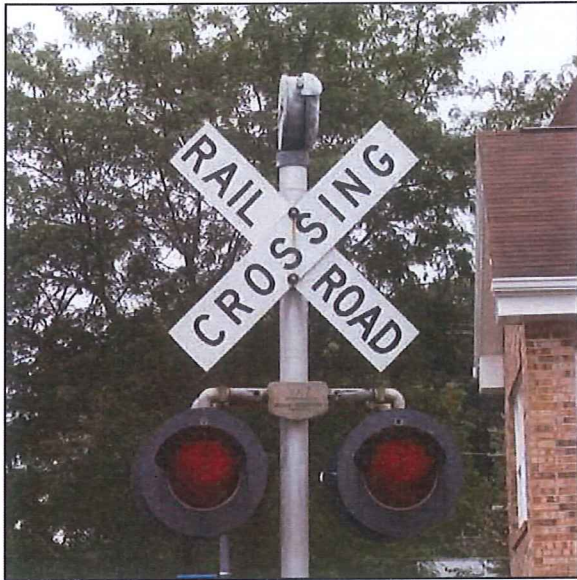


Be careful in these areas and take a different route when the road or sidewalk is closed.

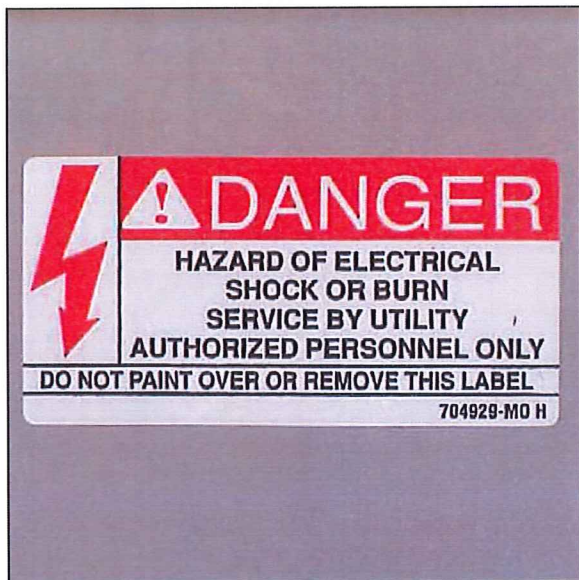

Often signs are used to protect us from things that are dangerous.

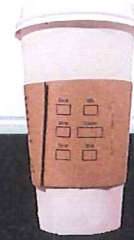
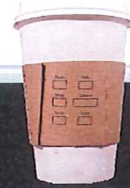


Others tell us where to go to stay safe.
